

Fickle Craftroom Crochet Necklace Tutorial

You will need:

Approx 380cm jersey yarn
9 or 10mm crochet hook
Optional: 2 chunky beads

10—20 minutes


Skill level: Easy



1. Make a slip knot, so that you have a loop and approx. 30-40cm tail.



2. Insert your crochet hook into the loop, yarn over (the long end, not the tail!) and pull through the loop – this is your first chain!



3. Repeat to make a second and third chain.



4. Insert your hook into the middle of the previous chain, yarn over, and pull through. You should now have 2 loops on your hook.



5. Now insert your hook into the very first loop in the chain, yarn over, and pull through – you should now have 3 loops on your hook.



6. Here's the tricky bit. Slide the first 2 loops off your hook and grip them with the thumb and forefinger of your left hand.



7. Yarn over, and pull through the loop currently on your hook.



8. Insert hook into the next loop (held by your left hand), yarn over, and pull through. You should now have 2 loops on your hook.



9. Repeat with the last loop (held by your left hand). You should now have 3 loops on your hook.



10. Repeat steps 6 to 9 until your crocheted cord measures around 20cm, and you have 3 loops on your hook.



11. Yarn over, and pull it through all 3 loops – you should now just have this one new loop on your hook. Snip your yarn, leaving approx. 30-40cm.



12. Yarn over, and pull the yarn all the way through, to secure your cord.



13. If you are adding beads, it may help to cut the end of each tail to make a point, before threading your beads. Knot tightly to secure them.



14. Tidy up your necklace by trimming the ends and giving it a stretch to even up any lumps.
